- ❖ Sourced from our over 100-Year-Old Zinfandel Vines at Puccioni Ranch that were planted by our Great Grandfather and Grandfather
- ❖ Cold Soaked, Small Open Top Fermentation with Hand Punch down, 15 months in Hungarian and French Oak barrels. Blended with Petite Sirah from Puccioni Ranch
- ❖ Tasting Notes: Aromas of ripe blackberry /cherry with layers of oak and spice, rich berry/chocolate flavors balanced with black pepper.
- ❖ Alcohol 16%, TA .69, pH 3.81
